What will the refurbishment look

Stage 1 - Rooms 1, 2 and office area.

Re-configuring of cloak-bay and toilets to create a break- out space for students and teachers to work in small groups or independently. This will include a wet area.

Alterations to staffroom, resource storeroom, principal office and sick

New phone and electronic bell system.

There will be two entry points per term, one on the first day of term and one at a mid-point during the term being the start of week 6.

**Emotionally Intelligent Parenting** 

Tuning in to Kids is an evidence-based programme designed to teach parents & caregivers:

- How to coach a child through periods of heightened emotion resulting in emotional regulation
- Awareness of their children's emotions
- To use children's emotional experiences as an opportunity for closeness and teaching
- Skills in assisting children to verbally label and manage their emotions
- Skills in assisting children to problem solve
- To guide children's behaviour with appropriate limits

## **Sessions include:**

- Watching video material
- Group discussions and exercises
- Role plays
- Home-based activities to practice different ways of responding to your child's emotions

Parents are encouraged to share experiences and ideas within the group
